



MARINA UTILITIES – WATER SEWER ELECTRIC FIRE PROTECTION

CHUB CAY BAHAMAS

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Chub Cay Bahamas complex and marina is located on the Bahamian Out Islands at the southernmost tip of the Berry Islands. This \$250 million dollar renovation included dredging the marina and channel to a deep water 12 foot depth at low tide, and upgrading from a 96 to a 110 slip facility, servicing yachts up to 200 feet in length, with a planned build out of 200 slips. Technically advanced marina utility systems designed and installed by Marina Utilities include concealed power cabling with multi functional electric power pedestals and other modern and convenient marina utilities – water, fire protection and in-slip pump out sewer systems. Floating concrete docks are by Bellingham Marine, with main piers 8-15 feet in width and finger piers 5-8 feet in width. A state-of-the-art computer-driven utilities plant is backed up to eliminate power outages and low water pressure. An additional flushing channel was built to protect the water quality of the marina. <http://www.chubcay.com/>
