## OLD PORT COVE MARINA NORTH AND SOUTH BASIN

---

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Old Port Cove Marina is the first megayacht facility of its size in the northern Palm Beaches and now can accommodate vessels from 30 feet to a maximum of 200 feet in length. Marina Utilities provided the design and installation of marina systems for the North and South Basins, where the \$22 million dollar redevelopment included replacing of the former docks, pilings and piers with new hardwood decked high-performance TechnoMarine floating docks. Systems provided by the marina were new pedestals, cable, WIFI, phone as well as the convenience of in-slip pump-out, providing significant environmental benefits in protecting the surrounding waterways, and eliminating the need for moving vessels for service. Old Port Cove Marina is designated as a State of Florida Clean Marina <sup>TM</sup>; the marina received grants totaling 75 percent of its pump out equipment costs from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FLDEP) for the installation of new pump-out facilities. These facilities provide an environmentally friendly way for boaters to pump out the waste-water from their boats so that it is disposed of appropriately, and not discharged into the waterways, where it can cause environmental pollution, harm human health and damage to fragile ecosystems. <http://www.opch.com>
